Workshop "Non-invasive Detection of Plant Responses in Greenhouses"

In November 2017, scientists and students from Geisenheim University and the University of Thessaly participated at a four-day workshop on **Non-invasive Detection of Plant Responses in Greenhouses** that took place in Geisenheim in the frame of the ZuGAbe project from the 7th until the 11th of November.

More than 15 scientists from both institutions gave talks or participated on discussions about the actual state as well as the future perspectives in the field of non invasive technologies in greenhouses in order to exchange knowledge and identify topics for future activities within the ZuGAbe project. Two external experts on phenotyping, Laura Junker from Research Center Jülich and Philipp von Gillhausen from the company Phenospex, also reported on their work in this area. After three days of presentations and extended discussions on the topic, participants had on the fourth and last day of the workshop the chance to visit the Research Center Jülich which is considered to be a leader on the research on phenotyping.
