



## Barcelona hosts the first Workshop City Protocol

The Workshop City Protocol to promote a certification system for measuring the degree of efficiency and quality in cities was held on 16 and 17 July. The event brought together around 200 spokespersons and included the attendance of two Metropolis representatives who played an active role in the discussions to establish a new framework for city improvement and transformation.

Barcelona City Council is acting as the project sponsor, with the involvement of CISCO and GDF Suez and the collaboration of over 90 cities, organizations, universities, and businesses.

The purpose of the event was to define in a collaborative and community-based fashion a protocol to determine quality standards for 21st century cities. The meeting drew 200 participants from 33 cities and close to 60 businesses, international organizations, and universities.

The goal of the Workshop City Protocol is to create a community from which a framework of governance can emerge that enables content on the challenges cities are faced with today for improving urban innovation to be generated in a collaborative fashion.

At the meeting in Barcelona participants agreed to develop and perfect a preliminary version of the City Protocol, which shall be presented at the Smart City Expo to also be held in Barcelona, from 13 to 15 November 2012. The basis and commitment for the creation of the City Protocol Society were further aspects also established at the event.





## “Superblocks” free up to 92% of public space in Barcelona!

MOBILITY URBAN PLANNING &amp; VISION



This simple idea is based on blocks, initially named “supermanzanas” (super apples), that are smaller in size than a district (but bigger than an apple!). These new 400mx400m urban blocks have given the city back to the citizens by keeping car traffic on the outskirts of each block. This urban development creates a peaceful, more spacious inner area, ideal for cycling and walking as well as testing new uses that encourage social cohesion and economic development. Several “super-apples” have already been created in the Gràcia district and others are in the process of being developed in Barcelona. This new idea is spreading to the cities of Vitoria, La Coruña, Ferrol, Viladecans and El Prat.



### Electric vehicle

Electric mobility is a good option for meeting people's motorised transport needs for journeys that cannot be made by more sustainable means such as travelling on foot, by bicycle or on public transport. In such cases, make sure you travel in the most efficient, clean and sustainable way possible.

In Barcelona, you have advantages for the use of the electric vehicle, with over 450 charging points distributed throughout numerous stations and car parks in all districts (125 are specifically for electric motorbikes), a 75% tax bonus on mechanical traction vehicles and a 0 Euro fee for parking in blue or green zone spaces (except spaces exclusively for residents or reserved spaces, always respecting the timetables and the maximum time regulations).

You'll also find a wide variety of shared electric vehicle services (mopeds and cars) in the city, which you can use for journeys where you need a private vehicle and you cannot go by public transport, on foot or by bike. Because you no longer need your own vehicle, you can benefit from the economic and environmental savings of a shared vehicle.

**WHAT IS BARCELONA WiFi?**

Barcelona WiFi is a Barcelona City Council service that enables you to connect to the Internet through WiFi access points, or hotspots, located in various municipal amenities and various public access points.

Barcelona WiFi is a service that provides users with simple internet browsing access and to this end, access to content can only be made through web browsers such as Mozilla Firefox, Microsoft Internet Explorer, etc. This service also provides citizens with access to information on and electronic procedures offered by the City Council. Through the Barcelona WiFi service Barcelona City Council aims to encourage citizens to access the internet and make it easier for citizens to incorporate this technology into their everyday lives.

To access Barcelona WiFi from any of the service access points, all you require is an IT device (laptop, computer, tablet, smart phone...) with a WiFi connection and an email address. To consult the technical requirements in more details, see the [service user manual](#).

To access the Service, Users must comply with the general terms and conditions of use of the service. Failure to comply with any of the provisions set out in the terms and conditions of use may result in the Barcelona WiFi service being withdrawn from the user. To start making the most of the Service, you should make sure you are within range of the antennas. Once you've made a connection using the Barcelona WiFi homepage you can accept the terms and conditions and use your email address and place of residence to register. A validation email will be sent to your address, you need to open it and click 'Begin to navigate'.

**TYPES OF BROWSING AVAILABLE**

Once you have accessed the home page of the service, you will be able to access:

**Internet access**  
enables you to browse the internet except for pages with content considered ethically dubious. So as not to alter the market, in accordance with current legislation, the connection speed is limited to 256 Kbps.

Latest news: The streetlights at the Llevant beach now make their own electricity

## The streetlights at the Llevant beach now make their own electricity

**Environment.** The lights work thanks to posts which use solar and mini wind power.

**The self-powered lighting at the Llevant beach, between Mar Bella and Diagonal Mar, includes 22 lighting units which were put into operation today. Six of the units use hybrid solar and mini wind power, while the other sixteen rely on solar power technology. The streetlights generate all the energy they need to function without having to be connected to mains electricity.**

In the case of the 6 hybrid lights, one of their specific features is that they have been specially designed for the city's wind resource and as such **they are the only units of their kind in the world which can function with wind strength below 1.7 m/s.** The streetlights use LED light technology and are highly energy efficient, with good quality light levels and a 20% lower energy consumption. They do not generate electricity costs as the energy they need is generated by each unit and can carry on working up to 58 hours, or 6 days without wind or sun.

In the case of the solar powered units, these 16 streetlights use LED technology and a solar panel which **allows them to operate with the sunlight they capture and without having to be connected to mains power.** As with the hybrid lights, these units can carry on working up to 6 days without sunlight.

The budget for the installation of the lights was 135,000 euros. It represents energy production of around 4,650 kWh per year, which works out at 280 kWh per year for the hybrid streetlights and 190 kWh per year for the solar powered units.

The high cost of operation and maintenance of street lighting is not only an economic problem but also an environmental concern. The application of measures such as control of lighting zones, regulation of the hours of lighting, improvements in facilities and electrical analysis of the position of lamps results in costs savings of up to 40%. Street lamps in the SIIUR project are equipped with LED technology to reduce cost and pollution. Lamps include sensors that process environmental information and detect presence, temperature, humidity, noise and pollution. These lights are connected to a street lighting cabinet that centralises all communications and services (such as fibre-optic cabling to the home, Wi-Fi or electrical vehicle recharging stations), and sends

### Plaça del Centre lights up with solar energy



Plaça del Centre, located between the districts of Les Corts and Sant-Montjuïc, has had a facelift over the last two months. Work carried out included the installation of a solar pergola which delivers energy to the 25 light fixtures around the square and the section of Av. Madrid which runs through it.

The installation of the pergola, which is 5 metres high and generates 12.48 kWp, charges fifteen lithium-ion batteries located in a special chamber underneath the square. The solar panels combine with wooden modules to form a shade structure and have been placed across the top of the pergola, which has a 5% incline to prevent rainwater, which cleans them, from accumulating on top.

The new system, which charges the batteries during the day and uses the accumulated energy to light the area at night, is expected to meet 70% of the annual power requirements of the square with clean and renewable energy. From April to August, the system will be able to supply 100% of the power needed.

**Prototyping the self-sufficient eco-house of the future in Valldaura Labs this summer**

Over the summer, the students from [the Institute of Advanced Architecture of Catalonia \(IAAC\)](#) have undertaken to prototype a fully off-grid and completely functional ecohouse in the forest of Valldaura. Committed to enhancing a more ecologically aware and self-sufficient future for architecture and housing, these students from IAAC's [Master in Advanced Ecological Buildings](#) will complete the construction at the end of August 2019. Privileging environmentally and ecologically conscious design as well as zero-km biomaterials. This prototype is the collective final project of the academic program offered from the IAAC's [Valldaura Labs](#), and the students have taken up the task to find viable alternatives to challenge current energy-consuming architectural methods using the skills, experience and knowledge they have learned during this academic year.




